
1. The Manson Parks and Recreation Board of Directors, approve the attached Manson Parks and Recreation District Comprehensive Plan.



RESOLUTION NO. 06-01



WHEREAS, the funds available for Manson Parks and Recreation District through presently scheduled programs are insufficient to meet the needs of the district, and

WHEREAS, park districts are authorized levies by a vote of the resident electors of the district, and

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are not available through any other known source;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Manson Parks and Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington: That a Primary Election will be held on the 19th day of September, 2006;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Manson Parks and Recreation District found it necessary for the public welfare, health and benefit, and in the best interest of the citizens of the District, to provide funds necessary for the day to day operation of the District;

"Shall Manson Parks and Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington, authorize the County Commissioners of Chelan County to levy in the year 2006 as the regular levy to be collected in 2007 and 2008, at the rate of approximately \$.38 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of the aforesaid district. The proceeds thereof to be placed in the Manson Parks and Recreation District and the Wapato Lake Campground maintenance and operation funds of the aforesaid district?"

Which shall be submitted to the electors of said district for their approval or rejection in the form of the following Ballot Title:

"Shall the Manson Parks and Recreation District be authorized to impose regular property tax levy of \$.38 or less per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for two consecutive years to be collected in the years of 2007 and 2008."

The Secretary of the aforesaid district is hereby directed to immediately transmit to the Chelan County Auditor a copy of this resolution, duly signed and attested, by which the Chelan County Auditor is hereby requested to take all procedural steps necessary and/or required by law to the end that this proposition shall be submitted to the voters of said district.

The foregoing resolution was adopted at a Manson Parks and Recreation District meeting of the Board of Directors of the aforesaid district on the 18th day of July, 2006, the undersigned directors being present and voting.




BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the taxing district that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2007 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$ 65,100
which is a percentage increase of 205 % from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of
(Percentage increase)

additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

These figures cover the new levy passed on 9/19/06 for 2007 and 2008 at .38 per \$1,000. We are not collecting anything from the levy passed in 2004 for 2005, 2006 and 2007.

APPOINTMENT OF AGENT TO RECEIVE CLAIMS
(RCW 4.96.020)


WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 4.96.020 the governing body of each local governmental entity shall appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages made under chapter 4.96RCW. The identity of the agent and the address where he or she may be reached during the normal business hours of the local governmental entity are public records and shall be recorded with the auditor of the county in which the entity is located. All claims for damages against a local governmental entity, or against any local governmental entity's officers, employees, or volunteers, acting in such capacity, shall be presented to the agent within the applicable period of limitations within which an action must be commenced. The failure of a local governmental entity to comply with the requirements of this section precludes that local government entity from raising a defense under chapter 4.93 RCW.




