WHEREAS, the funds available for Manson Parks and Recreation District through presently scheduled programs are insufficient to meet the needs of the district, and

WHEREAS, park districts are authorized levies by a vote of the resident electors of the district, and

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are not available through any other known source;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Manson Parks and Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington: That a Primary Election will be held on the 8th day of February, 2011;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Manson Parks and Recreation District found it necessary for the public welfare, health and benefit, and in the best interest of the citizens of the District, to provide funds necessary for the day to day operation of the District;

"Shall Manson Parks and Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington, authorize the County Commissioners of Chelan County to levy in the year 2011 as the regular levy to be collected in 2012, 2013, and 2014, at the rate of approximately \$.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2012, at the rate of approximately \$.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2013, and at a rate of approximately \$.23 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2014, of the aforesaid district. The proceeds thereof to be placed in the Manson Parks and Recreation District and the Wapato Lake Campground maintenance and operation funds of the aforesaid district?"
