



WAPATO LAKE CAMPGROUND

(December 2020)

Wapato Lake Campground is a small and family friendly campground located on peaceful Wapato Lake. The campground is open the last weekend in April (just in time for opening day of fishing season), through the end of September. The Campground offers 22 RV sites with water and power, 1 group camping site, and 13 tent sites. Each site allows for one vehicle and one sleeping unit (tent, RV, camp trailer, or camper). To keep the atmosphere pleasant and avoid congestion, no extra tents or extra vehicles are allowed. This facility offers a designated swimming area, restrooms with pay showers, fire pits in many sites, and picnic tables. While we do our best to accommodate specific site requests, site numbers are not guaranteed. A maximum of 4 people are allowed per site, however, exceptions can be made for families with young children.

All use of property in Wapato Lake Campground, and all conduct of persons, shall be in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations. These Rules and Regulations shall apply to each park visitor, tenant, and respective families and guests, employees, contractors, agents, and invitees of any campground tenant.

- “District” shall include authorized representatives or agents of the Manson Park and Recreation District.
- “Tenant” shall mean any person renting a site or other space in the campground.
- “Common Areas” shall mean parking areas, drive aisles, docks, picnic areas, swim areas, restrooms, and walkways within the park, and shall also include the surrounding waters of Wapato Lake.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are accepted up to 1 year in advance **from scheduled departure date**. They must be booked through the Manson Parks office at 509-687-9635. Reservations will be accepted in the order they are received. Departure dates may not be extended once booked. Payment in full is required at the time of booking. If paying by credit card, the reservation name must match the name on the credit card. A non-refundable \$5.00 administrative fee will be added to each reservation (per site). A \$10 Change Fee will apply to any changes made after the initial reservation.

In Parks We Play

LENGTH OF STAY

A 3-night minimum stay is required for Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day. Minimum 2-night stay required on all other weekends. Maximum length of stay shall not exceed 10 consecutive days.

CHECK-IN time is 3:00pm to 8:00pm; CHECK-OUT time is 12:00pm

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made 10 or more days before scheduled arrival date will be charged a \$20 cancellation fee. Cancellations made less than 10 days prior to the scheduled arrival date will not receive a refund. No-shows and early departures will not receive a refund. Subleasing of sites is not permitted. Refunds will not be given for circumstances out of the District's control, including but not limited to: weather, wildfire smoke, etc.

PARK RULES

- Quiet hours are 10:00pm to 8:00am.
- No firearms, fireworks, or weapons of any type on District property.
- Swimming is permitted in the designated area. An adult must accompany children while in the swimming area.
- Alcohol must stay within the tenant's designated campsite.
- NO ALCOHOL allowed on Memorial Day weekend.
- Campfires are allowed in designated fire rings only. Height of firewood in pits cannot extend beyond the top of the ring per local fire code. Burn bans may go into effect at any time.
- Speed limit in the campground is 5 miles per hour.
- Tenants operating watercraft must be of legal age and must abide the County's boating and water use regulations.
- No boats or boat trailers allowed in the campground.
- No subletting of sites.
- No mats, rugs, or vehicles on the grass at any time.
- Only one (1) tent, RV, or sleeping apparatus per site. Each site is allowed one (1) vehicle. All extra vehicles must be parked at the boat launch parking lot next to the campground.
- To maintain a more pleasant atmosphere, extra tents are not allowed.
- No smoking or vaping within 25 feet of office & restrooms.
- Remove sport nets when not in use.
- No glass permitted in swim areas or on docks.
- Do NOT drink from RED faucets; these are non-potable water.
- Keep personal items contained within your designated campsite.
- Do not attach any items to trees to avoid damage.
- No vehicle or trailer washing.
- No discharge of sanitation effluent is permitted.
- No offensive, profane, threatening, or indecent language or behavior.
- Common areas are to be kept clean at all times. Unattended items outside of designated sites will be removed by park staff.

RESTROOM RULES

- No pets.
- No bikes, scooters, or skateboards allowed in the restrooms.
- No dishwashing in the restrooms. A dishwashing station is located outside the women’s restroom.
- No disposal of household garbage in the restrooms.
- No glass.
- No smoking or vaping.

PETS

- Pets must be on a leash at all times and may not be left unattended.
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- Aggressive behavior or excessive barking will not be tolerated.

DISCLAIMERS

- Neither the District nor any agent of the District shall be responsible for loss or damage to Tenant property. Each Tenant shall be responsible for damage to any property of other Tenants and District common areas or facilities (including, without limitation, docks, buildings, and power pedestals) as a result of any actions by the Tenant or their vehicles.
- The District may bar Tenants from future leasing who violate these Rules and Regulations, for such a period of time as seems appropriate.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH RULES MAY RESULT IN EXPLUSION FROM CAMPGROUND. IF ASKED TO LEAVE, NO REFUND WILL BE ISSUED, NO EXCEPTIONS.
