



## RESOLUTION NO. 2020-08

### **A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN INVENTORY ITEMS DEEMED TO BE SURPLUS AND NO LONGER USED BY THE MANSON PARK & RECREATION DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, certain equipment owned by the Manson Park & Recreation District is no longer needed by the District; and

WHEREAS, State law requires a formal Resolution declaring the property to be surplus.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Manson Park & Recreation District that the equipment enumerated below is to be declared surplus to the foreseeable needs of the District. The Director of the District is authorized to coordinate the sale of the old Singleton Park playground equipment via auction to the highest bidder. The equipment includes a play structure with plastic and metal slides, a metal web climber, a wood and metal spring see-saw, metal slide, and a bench swing. All equipment will be sold in as-is condition and buyers will sign a hold harmless form releasing Manson Park & Recreation District from all liability relating to the purchase and use of said equipment.
