

RESOLUTION 2021-02

WHEREAS, Park District Boards may collectively vote to support or oppose a ballot measure at a properly noticed public meeting, (RCW 42.17.130)

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Manson Park & Recreation District, Chelan County, Washington, that the Board supports the passage of the April 27 th , 2021 ballot measure.
"Will the Manson Park and Recreation District be authorized to impose regular property tax levies of \$0.23 or less per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for each of three consecutive years, 2022, 2023, and 2024? YES "
This levy is to replace the expired Maintenance and Operation Levy which supports parks and programs to include, but not limited to, Singleton Park, Willow Point Park, Manson Bay Park lifeguards, and the AAU program.
The foregoing Resolution was adopted at a Manson Park & Recreation District public meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the aforesaid District on the 11^{th} day of February, 2021, of which due notice was given as required by law and with the following Commissioners being present and voting.
