

## **RESOLUTION 2021-03**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST ANYONE MOORING AT BOAT DOCKS OVERNIGHT WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION.

**WHEREAS**, The Chelan County Prosecuting Attorney's Office requires a resolution from the Manson Park and Recreation District Board of Commissioners, and;

WHEREAS, The Manson Park and Recreation District ("District") periodically reviews and revises its policies, and;

WHEREAS, the District manages the Manson Bay Marina for overnight moorage, and;

**WHEREAS**, the District does not permit overnight moorage without prior authorization at the Manson Bay Marina, Manson Bay day use docks, and Old Mill Park docks, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Manson Park and Recreation District Board of Commissioners require a civil penalty fee be charged to those who use said docks without prior authorization for overnight moorage.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Manson Park and Recreation District, that the following rule and penalty notice be posted and enforced at the aforesaid locations:

"No Unauthorized Overnight Moorage. \$100 Civil Penalty per Resolution 2021-03."

This Resolution supersedes Resolution 04-04 and replaces all other Resolutions pertaining to the same policy elements herein.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted at a Manson Park and Recreation District public meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the aforesaid District on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021, of which due notice was given as required by law and with the following Commissioners being present and voting.
