RESOLUTION NO. 2026-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE MANSON PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE RECREATION PROGRAM AND FACILITY USE AGREEMENT WITH MANSON GRANGE.

WHEREAS, the Manson Parks and Recreation District ("District") is authorized to provide recreational programming and community services for the public benefit; and

WHEREAS, the District's Vision Statement is to provide the community and its visitors with parks, recreation programs, and facilities operated in an efficient, safe, and aesthetic manner; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to partner with local community organizations to expand recreational program access without incurring additional capital facility costs; and

WHEREAS, the Manson Grange, a nonprofit organization, provides community facilities that may be utilized for public recreation programming; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative program described herein serves a valid public purpose by providing accessible fitness and wellness programming to community residents; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative arrangement provides adequate consideration through facility access at a reduced or waived rental rate in exchange for community recreation programming services; and

WHEREAS, the District does not act as a fiscal agent, does not collect program payments, and does not distribute participant fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that this partnership is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Manson Parks and Recreation District as follows:

Program Authorization

The District is authorized to enter into a Cooperative Community Recreation Program and Facility Use Agreement with Manson Grange.

Public Purpose Determination

The Board finds that this program serves a valid public purpose by providing accessible recreation programming consistent with the District's mission and vision.

Financial Structure

Participants may contribute program or facility use fees directly to Manson Grange. The District shall not act as a fiscal agent, nor shall it receive, manage, or distribute participant payments.
